# Suggested Supply List for Kindergarten 2024-2025



While we have many resources available in our classroom, we know that students often enjoy picking out their own supplies to bring to school. Below is a list of suggested supplies that may be purchased. However, Okemos Public Schools will ensure that your child has the supplies necessary for success in the classroom.

### Community Supplies

### Students with last names beginning A-K:

- ★ 1 package of napkins
- ★ 1 package (4 count) fine tip <u>black Expo</u> dry-erase markers
- ★ 1 Container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox, Lysol, etc.)

#### Students with last names beginning L-Z:

- ★ 1 box of <u>Crayola</u> multicultural skin tone crayons, colored pencils OR markers
- ★ 1 box of tissues
- ★ 1 bottle of hand sanitizer with pump

#### All Students:

- ★ 12 *sharpened* pencils (plain yellow)
- ★ 1 pack of Elmer's glue sticks
- ★ 1 box of <u>Crayola</u> crayons (24 count)
- ★ <u>Crayola</u> washable markers (broad tip)
- ★ 1 package of community snacks to share with the class. Please select a nut-free option such as:
  - Graham or animal crackers
  - o Pretzels
  - o Goldfish, Ritz, Town House, Cheez-It, or Club Crackers
  - o Cereal (Cheerios, Life, Quaker Oat Squares, Chex, Kix)
  - Individually packaged applesauce

### Please label the following items with your child's name:

- ★ Backpack
- ★ Art shirt (An oversized t-shirt works great for this.)
- ★ Gym shoes (Kindergartner students should wear closed-toe athletic shoes to school every day to ensure their safety. Flip-flops and sandals are not safe on our playground.)
- ★ Inexpensive headphones (not earbuds) labeled with student's name & placed in a gallon-size Zip-loc if possible for computer use.
- ★ Change of clothing in case of an accident (labeled in a gallon-size Ziploc bag)

Due to limited storage space, we may request additional classroom supplies again in January.
