Superintendent's Report - John Hood

• <u>Bond:</u> This summer every building is getting security upgrades, doors, cameras. OHS and Hiawatha getting secure vestibules.

Pool upgrades at OHS as well (ventilation and heating & cooling)

Chippewa new build starting June 6th! New carline. 2 years, then Cornell begins.

- <u>2nd Bond</u>: Sold \$77 million bonds (S&P AA rating), 39 investors; combined orders = \$539 million (lower yield 0.9) lowers debt. Fantastic bond sales.
- New: <u>"Prevent to Protect"</u> threat assessment (high risk students resources, support) through MSU Psychology Alyse Ley
- Policy change behavior threat assessment.
- Kinawa and other school had successful eclipse events.
- <u>Twitter/X</u> @superokemos
- MSB talk about best practices re: security
- <u>Staffing for next year</u>: Elementaries down 1-2 sections (as of now). 9 retirements, mostly at Chippewa.
- \$200K/year savings to prevent Covid funding cliff. We added so many resources that we do not want to lose.
- Budget is based on per pupil and enrollment
- <u>Protocol from power outage</u>: Was chaotic as the planning started at 7:20 am, 2 hours later than a normal call for no school.

Principal's Report - Steve Stierley

- <u>Eclipse event:</u> 570 kids, 750 people total went on the Toledo eclipse trip. They were on many news channels!
- <u>MSTEP</u>: 5th graders take all subjects Tuesday and Thursday. 6th graders just math and ELA.
- <u>Science night:</u> Kinawa and Chippewa did a combined event for the first time.

- Archery team middle school & HS (5/8-11): Louisville, KY for nationals
- Kinawa planning: numbers are pretty stable for next year.
- 5/21 4th grade visit

- Funded through Safety and Security grant
- Handout re: district security
- Retired from Lansing Police Department; was a gang resistance education instructor, was a trainer at Lansing PD, spoke at MSU
- 2022 OPS had district assessment, so following up with that.
- Will work with OPS Operations and do a lot this summer
- Helping with behavior threat assessment; work with SEC (Secure Environment Consultants)
- Create district standards so buildings are more similar/coordinated.
- Has good relationship with Meridian Township Police, FD
- Reunification and family assistance
- Site assessment; door numbering on all internal and external.
- Stop the bleed
- Technology safety
- Creating interior and exterior mapping shared with all responders, township micro and macro versions. There is security for these maps.
- Evacuation routes, where first aid is in all classrooms.
- Lots of new technology: cameras, new lockdown system (better for building leaders), card readers
- Working to secure each school. Need to include after school activities, field day, events renting out school facilities.
