Welcome and Introductions - Karen Shapiro

Superintendent's Report - Mario Martinez, Director of HR

- Also giving the report Sue Williams, HR Specialist (6 Okemos graduates)
- Not a lot of turnover this year. OHS no retirements, Chippewa and Elementary schools single digits.
- Post PT gym and preschool new specialists; possible elementary teacher.
- Food Services, Operations always in need of staff
- Amanda Patton, Director of Food Ops Big new project 5K Fundraiser (with Mike Devlin and others) to raise \$10 - 20K for 1 or 2 new Wolves costumes. Same company that did Sparty. Date of run: Saturday 8/24/24 - 9am -1pm. There will be stadium entertainment dance team, Fabricated Customs pop-up, concessions/food trucks. \$20 for smaller races, \$25 for 5K. Get a t-shirt and a medal. Contest between schools. Trane, McClaren, and other sponsors already. End of this week sign-ups will go out. (School starts 8/21).
- Question Corrinne What is the annual budget for costumes? Cleaning/repairing? Minimal. The costume would go to all the schools/big events.
- Once the costumes are bought, future fundraiser \$ could go to other things like a marquis sign.
- Question What is the cost of doing the 5K. Answer: still working on budget. (Security, McClaren nursing station, signage, Playmakers). Trying to roll costs into the admission fee.

Speaker - Brian Lieber, Operations Director

- He's been in the District since he was 3 years old! Wife and kids at OPM and Kinawa.
- Previously worked 19 years at a private company. He has a different vision and looking forward to change.
- **Bond**: Chippewa, Cornell, Kinawa. Also little projects but need to see how the big costs progress. 3 new buildings in 6 years.
- May 29th west side of Chippewa closed for construction.
- OPM can bring back old fields for use. Old Varsity stays, plus will use Kinawa/Dobie fields more.

- Years 3 & 4 Cornell at Chippewa. Have to save all material (expensive and needed).
- "Filter First" requirements Water coolers at Cornell so not to open walls (expensive). Add 6 fountains into OHS. 1 per 100 or access to filtered water.
- Already scheduled games will be moved. Contact the Township.
- Grounds crews: trouble keeping up in the spring. Need more modern equipment. Budget for next year. Need better planning: Maintenance in old vs. buying better new. Goals: figure out inefficiencies. Adopt value-added based thought, and health and safety #1 issue.
- Needs vs. Wants. Custodial need not enough; issues with people not showing up. Cornell - contractor. All schools using the same company. (After school we don't use OPS people). This summer: new standard for "clean"
- Cornell issues with kitchen cleanliness (Food Services issue). Okemos people are operations just floors and trash.
- Question: Stacey S lunchroom help: need more at Hiawatha. Answer: Mario Hard finding PT people; make it worth someone's time/money.
- We will invite him back for updates next year.

Board of Education Report - Mary Gebara

- Adopting 200 new policies (with Thune Law Firm). 35 more to go through.
- Tonight Gun safety legislation Governor's new resolution. Asking OPS families to sign a letter: pledge for gun safety.
- June 6th, 5:30 pm big groundbreaking ceremony at Chippewa
- Wrapped up the Start Times committee. They know and agree with the science of starting later BUT: we would be the only ones doing it (which causes scheduling issues) and it's an after school disaster. The push now is for County collaboration/talk to ISD.
- Will cost \$5M for 2 year Cornell bussing to Chippewa
- Hiawatha carline issue: so much opposition; so much \$. Pushed to 2026-27 school year. Playground equipment moving forward.
- Target for new website this summer.
