Welcome to the 2024-2025 school year! We are optimistic that this year is going to be fantastic. We have listed some important dates on the left.

KICKSTART: This is the first opportunity for students to receive their schedules. PowerSchool will not be live until later that week, so this is early access! All students will get their pictures taken (and receive their new school IDs), have an opportunity to turn in paperwork, register for parking, set up/practice their lockers, sign up for clubs, and check out the school!

FRESHMEN CONNECT: All freshmen are invited to attend a special orientation on Thursday, August 15th, from 1-3 pm. They will meet other freshmen and be assigned two upperclassmen mentors. It's a time to tour the school, try out lockers, learn how to get from class to class, meet new people, and get to know the school. We encourage all freshmen to attend. Please have them bring their phone (or a parent's phone number), as we will set up text message groups for continued communication. They should bring their schedule and locker information. The connected leaders cannot wait to meet the incoming freshman!

OPEN HOUSE: This is an informal open house. The parent meeting is most critical for parents who are brand new to the high school. All are welcome, though. After the parent meeting, this is your opportunity to check out the school and meet the teachers. There are no bells or schedules. It is more like a meet and greet to get the vibe of the school. There is NO NEED for students to attend (they probably don't want to either, lol).

END-OF-DAY ROUTINE

At 3pm every day, students may do the following:

- 1. Head home.

Students and families need to plan ahead. We cannot have students unsupervised in the building after 3 pm. Unsupervised students will be asked to leave the building at 3 pm, which seems counterintuitive, I know. We do not have the human resources to supervise them after school.

THE INFAMOUS CAR LINE

The student entrance off of Hulett Road is the only space where students who are driving or getting a ride to school should be entering the building. The bus loop is closed to non-staff for safety reasons, and the guest entry off of Jolly Road is currently closed for construction. This was also the case last year, and thankfully, all students and staff were still able to get to school on time when they planned ahead.

Here's the thing: if you get here by 7:15, you'll have a stress-free, easy time. If you arrive at 7:30, it's going to be busy. Plan ahead. For after school, you can plan to be at the school early, or pick up your student 15 minutes after school lets out to avoid the first wave. Make a plan that works for your family, and please be courteous to others.
