AP EXAM REGISTRATION, MAY 2025 CYCLE

Any student who is enrolled in an AP course through Okemos High School is expected to register for and complete the corresponding AP exam. Students may also register for AP exams for which they play to self-study, though we recommend students be realistic about such plans, as our experience has been that many students register with good intentions but end up canceling their exam and surrendering some or all of their exam fees. Harvey, a Pulitzer Prize-winning comedy by Mary Chase, is the story of a perfect gentleman, Elwood P. Dowd, and his best friend, Harvey — a six-foot tall, invisible rabbit. When Elwood begins introducing Harvey around town, his embarrassed sister, Veta Louise, and her daughter, Myrtle Mae, decide to commit Elwood to a sanitarium. A mistake is made, however, and Veta is committed rather than Elwood! What ensues is a comedy of errors resulting in mistaken identities, misdiagnoses, and a search for the elusive rabbit that reminds us to embrace the quirks that make us special.

Registration is now open for the AMC 10 and AMC 12 Math Competitions!

What are the AMC 10 and AMC 12?

The AMC 10 and AMC 12 are both 25-question, 75-minute, multiple-choice examinations in high school mathematics designed to promote the development and enhancement of problem-solving skills.

What material is covered on the AMC 10 and AMC 12?

The AMC 10 covers mathematics normally associated with grades 9 and 10. The AMC 10 assumes knowledge of elementary algebra and basic geometry knowledge, including the Pythagorean Theorem, area and volume formulas, elementary number theory, and elementary probability. What are excluded are trigonometry, advanced algebra, and advanced geometry. The AMC 12 covers the entire high school mathematics curriculum, including the above, as well as trigonometry, advanced algebra, and advanced geometry, but excludes calculus.

The AMC 10 and AMC 12 are the first in a series of competitions that eventually lead <u>all the way</u> to the International Mathematical Olympiad.

Who is eligible for the AMC 10 and AMC 12 math competition? AMC 10-(OHS)

Students enrolled in Okemos Schools in 9th-10th grade may participate in the AMC 10. To be eligible to participate in the AMC 10, students must be below and under 17.5 years of age on the day of the competition.

AMC 12-(OHS)

Students enrolled in Okemos Schools in 9th-12th grade may participate in the AMC 12. To be eligible, students must be below and under 19.5 years of age on the day of the competition.

The competition will be held on November 6th, 2024. See your math teacher or Mrs. Heethuis with any additional questions. The cost to participate is \$6 and registration can be found at <u>https://okemosk12.revtrak.net</u>
