We have an important BOND UPDATE for you. We are fortunate the voters have approved bond funds for a secured vestibule at Okemos High School. Starting on May 20th, the office will be relocated to a classroom by the student athletic entrance.

Our normal office entrance will not be available for ANY STUDENTS, PARENTS, OR VISITORS. The reason for this change during the school year is that we need to set up our temporary office so work can begin as soon as possible at the end of the year.

These changes will exist starting on May 20th until probably around Winter Break of 2024. In short, starting on May 20th, ALL parents and students MUST use the athletic entrance as the Jolly Road entrance will be CLOSED.

Commitment to Excellence Awards


